By Plane:

Fresno Yosemite International Airport is the closest, most convenient Airport to access all three national parks! Fly in from any one of 15 non-stop destinations with minimal congestion and retrieve your rental car or catch your scheduled guided tour to begin your adventure.

By Car:

Stay in Visalia, closest city to Sequoia, for a fresh morning start.

Day 1: Wake up in Visalia and start the morning with a scenic drive to Sequoia National Park for a day of exploration. That evening return to Visalia and enjoy a hearty dinner and a peaceful night's rest.

Day 2: Get an early start to explore the amazing Kings Canyon National Park. Stay the night in Oakhurst at one of their many lodging options off of Highway 41 near the south gate to Yosemite.

Day 3: See majestic Yosemite National Park. Drive in or take a guided tour and spend the day experiencing this beautiful park.
